Family Discussion Questions:

1. What does it feel like to be around someone who is proud, thinking they are better than everyone else?
2. Why is it easy to talk about me and hard to ask about someone else?
3. How does asking about someone else help you learn to be humble?
4. How can we learn to be humble toward one another in our family?

Let's Pray Together

- Thank God for each member of your family and mention something specific that you appreciate about them.
- Ask Him to help you be a humble learner in your family and about each person.
- Ask God to remind you when you start acting proud to step down and be humble.
- Ask Him to help us be a family that is humble and caring about others.

Suggestions: Gather your family and ensure that everyone is seated comfortably. Hopefully each member of the family can be seen and heard easily by everyone. Pray together, read the verse for today and then watch the video together. Pause the video after each of the discussion questions and encourage each family member to share. Afterwards, pray together following the suggested prayer points. Hopefully the discussion will continue throughout the day in a natural way. Another idea is to have one parent view the video in advance and then teach the lesson on their own without showing the video to the family.
