Family Discussion Questions:

1. Why is it so easy for us to get into arguments over little things?
2. In a real war, people get injured really badly and even die. What happens to our relationship at home when we get into battles with one another?
3. If we made some rules or guidelines for handling disagreements at home, what would be some important things to put on that list?
4. What do you think a home without any peace between family members would be like? How would that feel?
5. If our family really learned how to live at peace with one another, what do you think it would be like for other people to visit us?

Let's Pray Together

- Thank God for making peace with us through the sacrifice of Jesus.
- Ask Him to forgive us for the times we didn't care about peace, when we just wanted to win or have our own way.
- Ask God to help us care more about our relationships as family members than we do about winning.
- Ask Him to help us become a home that demonstrates the peace of God in real life.

Suggestions: Gather your family and ensure that everyone is seated comfortably. Hopefully each member of the family can be seen and heard easily by everyone. Pray together, read the verse for today and then watch the video together. Pause the video after each of the discussion questions and encourage each family member to share. Afterwards, pray together following the suggested prayer points. Hopefully the discussion will continue throughout the day in a natural way. Another idea is to have one parent view the video in advance and then teach the lesson on their own without showing the video to the family.
