A Few Tips to Help You On Your First Visit...

Should we need to contact you during the Worship Service, you'll be given a temporary ID number which will show on two Call Board Displays located to the left and right of the stage in the auditorium. Please be sure to locate these displays once you are seated. Let us know about any special needs for your child including: health issues, allergies, feeding instructions or any other special individual needs.

While you are in Worship Service your child will also have an opportunity to spend time hearing God's Word from very caring adults. Each Sunday a Bible lesson is spoken to even our littlest babies. Worship music is an important part of their experience with God.

The older children in the nursery will participate in a simple craft that reinforces the main Bible teaching point. Children will practice a memory verse and have a time of prayer. A light snack and water are offered as well. ("From infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus." 2 Timothy 3:15)

We hope your visit with us will be significant in many ways. If you choose to join us again, you can help us better serve your child by bringing the following:

- A diaper bag with diapers and a change of clothes (just in case)



- A bottle or sippy-cup of beverage, marked with your child's name.
- A favorite item of comfort for your child. (Many children in a new environment may need their blanket, stuffed animal or pacifier for security and comfort.)
- If your child has allergies, please bring a favorite snack.

Well-Baby Policy

To help ensure a comfortable Nursery environment, we have a "Well Baby Policy." We ask that you keep your child with you in the church service or at home if they have any of the following symptoms or illnesses:

- Fever, runny nose, rash, coughing or diarrhea
- Any contagious illnesses such as, chicken pox, measles, mumps and pink eye.
- If your child is being treated with antibiotics, he/she should be on the medication for at least 24 hours before coming into the Nursery.
- If your child has a continually clear-runny nose or rash due to non-contagious allergies, please let us know. We realize that some symptoms linger after the child is no longer contagious.

Remember, we want all of our children to remain healthy and happy.



Did You Know We are a Co-Op Style Nursery?

Our Nursery is primarily staffed using a "Parent-Assisted Co-Op" in tandem with adult volunteers from our church.

A Parent Assisted Co-Op is a staffing system for our Nursery Ministry in which parents serve once a month along side our regular ministry volunteers. This has proven to be a great model in the following ways:

- Classrooms are consistently staffed
- Provides parents with the launching pad for nurturing the faith of their own children and consequently the faith of the next generation
- Parents can build relationships with other parents, by serving in the Nursery
- Provides opportunity for parents to model "serving at church" to their children
