

We hope you are excited about the opportunity to serve in either the Bahamas or Ecuador in 2020!

We have the opportunity to travel and live out God's call to reach the nations with the good news of Jesus. We will be traveling to two locations in 2020: the Bahamas and Ecuador. HSM has been blessed this next year with the ability to take two separate teams to two very different locations around the world. We are very excited about how the Lord will move as we obey Him and carry out the commandment of loving our neighbors!

THE DETAILS:



<u>COST</u>: **\$1794** - primarily by donations raised (see payment page)

TRIP DATES: April 4th-11th, 2020.

Note: Time and day of departure may change based upon airline ticket options. Leave at least a 24hr "buffer" on both ends of the trip.

<u>COST</u>: **\$2598** - primarily by donations raised (see payment page)

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Who Can Go?: Any current High School student.

<u>Can I pick which trip?</u>: We do one application that counts for both trips. They both have the same requirements and are open to the same students. If you have a preference, we may ask students in the interviews but hope that each student is open to go on either. If a student cannot make one trip for previous commitment reasons, there is a place to indicate that on the application.

<u>Transport:</u> We will be flying out of Sea-Tac Airport to a connecting flight in the United States that will take us to the Bahamas or Ecuador. From there we will take vans to our various locations in country.

<u>Safety</u>: Our #1 concern is and will always be SAFETY! We can't promise what we can't control, but we do promise that we will do everything we can to make this trip as safe as possible. We have a relationship with both global outreach organizations and trust their experience and safety with student trips. That being said, there is ALWAYS an inherent risk when traveling to another country.

Global Outreach Organization:

THE BAHAMAS: For this trip, we are partnering with Praying Pelican Missions (PPM). PPM began in 2003 serving two communities in Belize. They expanded to Jamaica in 2007 and are now annually serving in 14 countries around the world and in more than a dozen cities across the US. Their staff includes more than 400 individuals both in the U.S. and in the local communities where teams serve. Through PPM, more than 50,000 short-term missionaries have served in over 350 different communities throughout their locations. *Check out prayingpelicanmissions.org for more info.*

ECUADOR: For this trip, we are partnering with IberoAmerican Ministries. IberoAmerican Ministries (IAM), is a non-profit mission organization founded in 1992 in the USA. Founded in Chile in 1977, it now includes nearly twenty churches and many equipping ministries in Chile, Ecuador, Peru and Spain, with exploratory work now being done among unreached peoples. IAM's team includes over 30 families and individuals serving as missionaries and interns in North and South America, Europe, and among unreached peoples. IAM's outreach involves various ministries, including evangelism, leadership training, church planting, schools, children's ministries, music ministries, missionary recruiting, construction and a two-year training program for new missionaries. *Check out iamweb.org for more info.*

- 4. The HSM Team will contact you to schedule an interview with trip leaders (Rob and Amy).
- 5. All members who have been accepted onto the team will receive a team member packet with all important documents and pre-trip meeting information.

THE REQUIREMENTS

PAYMENT: We understand that the cost of the trip is often the biggest factor in determining a student's ability to attend. While each student is responsible for his/her portion of the cost by the dates provided, we will help them in the process of raising support. Each student is required to raise support through letters and donations. We will help train and equip them to raise through support letters. Support goal dates are in place because the church will be purchasing airfare ahead of time. Please note the fundraising goals on the next page and know that each student must be fully fundraised before the trip begins. If goals are unmet or the balance is not reached, it may result in a student not being able to go.

<u>APPLICATION</u>: Each student must complete an application that covers his or her beliefs, gifting, and personality. We don't expect students to be perfect, but because we are sharing the message of and representing Christ, we must send a team of people who will represent the following areas well: HSM, our church and the God we are sharing about.

<u>ATTENDANCE</u>: Every team member must consistently attend HSM or Canyon Hills Community Church. We serve as a community and want students to build relationships with the students and staff they will be serving with. We also want students to remain a part of the ministry after the trip, so this isn't an isolated experience for them.

<u>TEAM MEETINGS:</u> Students are required to attend each meeting with the exception of one absence. If a student knows they would miss more than one for pre-existing commitments, please list that on the application and we will take that into consideration.

THE BAHAMAS: there will be *no exceptions for Jan 19 and March 29*. There are 11 meetings. See the meeting dates on the "Pre-trip Meeting Dates" page.

ECUADOR: there will be no exceptions for Feb 23, May 2-3 (overnight trip), and June 14. There are 15 meetings. See the meeting date on the "Pre-trip Meeting Dates" page.

<u>HEALTH:</u> Students must be physically and emotionally healthy enough to travel and work in a hot, physically taxing and stressful environment. It is vital that students and parents disclose any medical and non-medical issues that could be a factor. We reserve the right to ask a student off the team for any reason that would jeopardize themselves or other team members.

<u>PASSPORT:</u> Every team member must have a valid US Passport. It must not expire within 6 months of the last day of the trip, meaning,

THE BAHAMAS: if your passport expires before Oct 12, 2020, you will need to renew.

ECUADOR: if your passport expires before Dec 30, 2020, you will need to renew.

This is a governmental mandate. If you need to get or renew your passport do so immediately after being accepted onto the team. We need passports for plane ticket purchases. Raised trip funds do not cover passport renewal cost (approx. \$165)

FINANCIAL DATES

Financial goals and pre-trip meetings are vital part of the trip process. We purchase non-refundable plane tickets and it's important students work hard in fundraising.



By Jan 19, Sunday – Day of First Team Meeting

\$200 Non-refundable deposit to hold spot. This counts towards final cost raised. Only turn in once notified of being on the Ecuador Team. Do not turn in with application.

By Feb 16, Sunday:

\$1,000 total.

This will be when plane tickets are purchased. It is vital that this amount is raised by this date.

By March 29, Sunday:

\$1,794 The full trip balance that must be raised and turned in by this date.



By Feb 23, Sunday - Day of First Team Meeting

\$200 Non-refundable deposit to hold spot. This counts towards final cost raised. Only turn in once notified of being on the Ecuador Team. Do not turn in with application.

By March 22, Sunday:

\$1,000 total.

By April 19, Sunday:

\$1,600 total. This will be when plane tickets are purchased. It is vital that this amount is raised by this date.

By May 17, Sunday:

\$2,200 total.

By June 14, Sunday:

\$2,598 The full trip balance that must be raised and turned in by this date.
