Family Discussion Questions:

1. When someone wants you to do the right thing, what works best- punishment, nagging or encouragement? Why?
2. If you're trying to nudge someone in the family to be more respectful to others, what kinds of things could you do to encourage that?
3. Without saying you're getting 'cold' or 'warmer' what kinds of words could we use with one another as reminders or encouragers?
4. What would it be like if everyone in our family decided to nudge each other to do loving and good things all the time?

Let's Pray Together

- Thank God for teaching us how to love one another and to do good things.
- Ask Him to forgive us for the time when we nagged or complained about our family members.
- Ask God to help us be learners, really understanding our family members.
- Ask Him to help us point one another in the right direction, to please God in everything we do and say.

Suggestions: Gather your family and ensure that everyone is seated comfortably. Hopefully each member of the family can be seen and heard easily by everyone. Pray together, read the verse for today and then watch the video together. Pause the video after each of the discussion questions and encourage each family member to share. Afterwards, pray together following the suggested prayer points. Hopefully the discussion will continue throughout the day in a natural way. Another idea is to have one parent view the video in advance and then teach the lesson on their own without showing the video to the family.
