THE POWER OF PRAYING TOGETHER

Acts 4:23-37 November 13, 2022

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. Why do you think we need to pray with others?
- 2. When you need prayer, to whom do you go?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message. Read Acts 4:23-37

- 3. How did the disciples express their unity in their confidence in God (vs. 24-28, Ps 2:1-2). What attributes of God did they call to mind in their prayers?
- 4. How does John 19:1-11 confirm God's complete control of every situation as expressed by the disciples' prayer in verse 28?
- 5. What did the disciples ask for in verses 29-30? What did they not ask for? How should this direct our prayers?
- 6. What is the purpose of the signs and wonders as evidenced by the aftermath of the signs? See Acts 3:6-10 and 4:4, 5:12-13, 8:4-8, 9:33-35, and 9:36-41.

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

- 7. What kinds of prayers do you pray? How do they compare with the disciples' prayer in today's passage?
- 8. What is going on in your life right now for which you need prayer? Take time in your group to bring these requests to the Lord.
