### THE POWER OF PRAYING TOGETHER

*Acts 4:23–37 November 13, 2022*

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

1. Why do you think we need to pray with others?
2. When you need prayer, to whom do you go?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message. [Read Acts 4:23-37](#)

3. How did the disciples express their unity in their confidence in God (vs. 24-28, Ps 2:1-2). What attributes of God did they call to mind in their prayers?
4. How does John 19:1-11 confirm God's complete control of every situation as expressed by the disciples' prayer in verse 28?
5. What did the disciples ask for in verses 29-30? What did they not ask for? How should this direct our prayers?
6. What is the purpose of the signs and wonders as evidenced by the aftermath of the signs? See Acts 3:6-10 and 4:4, 5:12-13, 8:4-8, 9:33-35, and 9:36-41.

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

7. What kinds of prayers do you pray? How do they compare with the disciples' prayer in today's passage?
8. What is going on in your life right now for which you need prayer? Take time in your group to bring these requests to the Lord.
