START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. Have you been in a situation where your faith and ability to trust God has been challenged?
- 2. How do you know if someone is really strong in trusting God?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

- 3. Read Acts 5:17-18. Describe how the Apostles are being persecuted by men in authority. How does Satan factor into this? (See 1 Peter 5:8, Ephesians 6:12).
- 4. Read Acts 5:19-21, Matthew 10:19-20, John 14:26. Describe how God is involved in the rescue of the Apostles. How is the Word of God vital in facing persecution?
- 5. Read Acts 5:27-32. Describe the Apostles' response when told to stop preaching. How were they strengthened as they feared God, rather than the religious leaders? (See Phi 1:21 and Luke 12:4-5).

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

- 6. Who is ultimately in charge of the trials and persecution you are facing and how can you be encouraged to trust God?
- 7. Describe how you have "drawn the line in the sand" in obeying and fearing God, as you respond to trials and persecution in your life.
