START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. What are some things or people that have influenced your life and who you are?
- 2. Do you have friends who were gung-ho Christians and now have fallen away?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

- 3. Read Acts 8:9-13. Describe how these verses show it is possible to know and respond outwardly towards God.
- 4. Read Acts 8:14-21. Describe the difference between head knowledge and heart knowledge of the Gospel.
- Read Acts 8:22-25. How was Simon's heart described in these verses and how was he rebuked by Peter?
- 6. Read Matthew 7:15-23. Describe what these verses say about consequences of bearing good fruit vs bad fruit.

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

- 7. What fruits are hanging on the tree of your Christian life? Are they stapled on as Koby mentioned?
- 8. What are some of the ways you are living by following Jesus one day at a time, surrendering your head knowledge to heart knowledge of God?
- 9. Are you a Simon? Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to show you how you can surrender the agenda of your life so you can live out God's will for your life.
