Acts 9:20-31 February 5, 2023

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. What have you added to or changed in your life that you thought would make it better only to find that it had a different effect?
- 2. What are some common expectations that people have about committing their lives to Christ?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

Read Acts 9:20-31

- 3. Pastor Steve said genuine faith in Jesus will change your life (1 John 2:3-6). How did Saul demonstrate that his faith in Jesus had radically changed his life?
 - a. Acts 9:20
 - b. Acts 9:22
 - c. Acts 9:27-28
- 4. What obstacles did Saul have to overcome to prove the sincerity of his faith in Jesus?
 - a. Acts 9:21
 - b. Acts 9:26-27.
- 5. Pastor Steve also said becoming a Christian will often result in some people desiring to hurt or embarrass us. How did Saul experience the threats on his life? See Acts 9:23-24, 25, 29-30.

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

- 6. What are some obstacles that we might need to overcome to prove the sincerity of our faith in Jesus?
- 7. Read John 15:18-20. How are we to respond to the realities of these verses? See also Hebrews 3:6, 14, 1 Corinthians 1:8-9 and Luke 6:22-23.
- 8. Describe the changes in your life since becoming a Christian.
