

HELPFUL INFO FOR MSM PARENTS

LEADERS: We prioritize placing students with their Life Group leaders or leaders that will possibly be their Life Group leaders in the fall. If Life Group leaders are unable to come, we place them with adults that are MSM leaders. Each cabin leader coming to camp has filled out a theological questionnaire, passed a background check, and has met individually with someone on our Student Ministry staff and have communicated and demonstrated a clear love for students and the Lord.

TRANSPORTATION: Canyon Hills provides transportation to and from camp. Drop off your student at Canyon Hills for Check-In on Friday, and we will update parents via text (see below) on Tuesday when buses should arrive back at church.

CABINS: Because we have such a high value for developing biblical community, cabin groups are formed with students who are members of their Life Group. When a student registers, they can indicate their Life Group OR request a couple of friends to room with and we will place them in a cabin with at least one of those friends. All cabin groups are formed by grade and gender.

FREE TIME:

Activities: There are lots of activities available during free time for all students including horseback riding, paintball, lakefront swimming, paddleboarding and canoeing as well as many group lawn games like 9-square, gaga ball, volleyball, etc.

Supervision: Students are consistently overseen by leaders, whether it is their cabin leader or camp staff. We also set clear boundaries for students at the beginning of camp to help ensure a safe and positive camp experience.

6th grade student cabins for most of free time will have designated scheduled activities accompanied with cabin leaders and/or MSM camp staff.

INJURIES/SICKNESS: We have a camp nurse that can help with basic injuries and will contact student's emergency contact if student needs extra care or any medications. If a student is homesick, we would pray with them and encourage them join in during activities and small group time and hopefully those feelings will pass. If they do not, we will reach out to the parent/guardian to see how they would like to move forward.
