God Changes Hearts

Acts 16 April 16, 2023, Pastor Koby Orr

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

1. Think of someone in your life who appears to be far from God. Describe your experience in trying to reach them with the gospel of Jesus.
2. Describe how God has changed *your* heart.

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

3. Read Acts 16:1-12. What insight into the providence of God do we learn from this passage?
4. Pastor Koby said, "God is willing and able to save all who seek Him." Read Acts 16:13-15 and Romans 8:30. How do these verses describe the salvation of Lydia and the hope and assurance of our own salvation?
5. Read Acts 16:16-18 and 1 Corinthians 1:18. How did Pastor Koby explain the principle that not everyone who hears the gospel is changed by the gospel?
6. Read Acts 16:25-31. How do these verses demonstrate that God can even save those who aren't looking for Him and what encouragement does that give us?

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

7. Pastor Koby said, "God changes hearts, and our job is simply to be faithful." How are we to display our faithfulness to a watching, unbelieving world and what must we be willing to become to them? See 2 Corinthians 2:15-16.
8. How can your Life Group help you become more faithful in prayer and worship?
