### **Revelation 1:1-3 – Hope for Christians**

What do believers do as we wait for Jesus' return?

- 1. Be about the work of the Lord.
- 2. Continue to learn His Word and be in community.
- 3. Teach the next generation.
- 4. Live a holy and obedient life.
- 5. Tell others about Jesus. He longs that no one perishes.
- 6. Continue to pray for our world, our community, and our culture. That they see Jesus in us!

TAKE AWAY: Revelation is God's HOPE to believers! Those who hear and heed it will be blessed!

## **Revelation 1:4-8 - Attributes of Jesus**

1.	Who is, Who was and is to Come - Verse 4
	Question: Where do you find your rest and hope?
2.	Faithful witness - Verse 5
	Question: Where do you need Jesus' perfect peace in your life?
3.	Firstborn of the dead - Verse 5
	Question: Where do you need heart transformation?
4.	Ruler of the Kings of the earth - Verse 5
	Questions: What is your response to the world and events? Leaders of nations? The daily news?



5.	God's	great love	and	freedom	- \	/erse	5

Questions: How often are you aware of God's great love for you? His sacrifice? His power?

- 6. Truth of the 2<sup>nd</sup> coming Verses 7-8
  - It's imminent.
  - It gives God glory.
  - It's absolute certainty.
