

# Message Session One: Revelation 4 - The Throne Room of Heaven

### Big Idea: God rules with absolute Power and Justice

- 1. Jesus opens the door to heaven for John (v.1)
- 2. Jesus is the voice like the sound of a trumpet (v.1)
- 3. Jesus shows John the throne room (v.2)
- 4. God the Father is the One that sits on the throne (v.3)
- 5. Emerald Rainbow (v.3)
- 6. 24 Thrones with 24 Elders (v.4)
- 7. Flashes of lightning and thunder (v.5)
- 8. 7 Lamps and 7 Spirits (v.5)
- 9. Sea of Glass (v.6)
- 10. 4 Living creatures (v.6)



### TAKE AWAY

- God is faithful to give comfort amidst our suffering when we focus on eternity.
- God deserves all of us, He alone deserves our total worship.
- God's people worship Him by their lives of obedience.

#### Read Romans 12:1-2

Whom do I worship?

After reading and studying the throne room of God: If God is sovereign and eternal, then who do I believe is in control of my life; God or me?

Take a moment to write down who or what controls your life? (Your personal life, marriage, singleness, parenting, workplace, friendships, etc)

How is my life a living sacrifice to the Lord?

Write a prayer asking God to help you release this situation or suffering to Him.



## Message Session Two: Revelation 5 - The Lamb and the Scroll

### Big Idea: Jesus alone is worthy

- 1. God the Father holds the scroll in His right hand (v.1)
- 2. Angel proclaims, "Who is worthy?" (v.2)
- 3. No one was found worthy! John wept (v.3-4)
- 4. The Lion of Judah and the Root of David, He is able! (v.5)
- 5. Lamb that was slain standing at the center of the throne (v.6)
- 6. Jesus takes the scroll (v.7)
- 7. 4 Living creatures and 24 elders fell before the Lamb (v.8)
- 8. Harps and Golden bowls (v.8)
- 9. They sang a new song (v.9)



### TAKE AWAY

- Jesus Christ is the only one worthy of worship because HE conquered sin and the evil one. He is the only one who can redeem the world.
- Believers can embrace His loving authority over our lives knowing HE is in control.

#### Take a moment to write a prayer:

How do I enter my time in praise and adoration?

Is my heart divided? What divides my heart? Will you give that situation to the Lord? Ask Him for help!

Ask God to remind you of why His Son is truly worthy of our worship and authority over our lives.
