Passing Life's Tests

James 1:1-12 January 7, 2024

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. Think of a past trial and explain how you persevered through it and how you were changed by it.
- 2. If you had to go through the same trial again, what would you do differently?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

- 3. Pastor Steve said, "Trials are the reality of the Christian life." Read James 1:2, 1 Peter 4:12, Job 5:7, and Ecclesiastes 9:12. What do these verses teach us about trials in the Christian life?
- 4. Read James 1:3-4, 1 Peter 1:6-7 and 1 Corinthians 1:8-9. What are the purposes that God has ordained for our trials? (Pastor Steve gave us three.)
- 5. Pastor Steve said, "Our trials call for three faith responses." In each of the passages below, describe how we should respond in faith to the trials we may encounter:
 - a) James 1:2
 - b) James 1:5-8
 - c) James 1:9-11
- 6. Read James 1:12 and Hebrews 2:10. What has God promised to those who love Him and remain steadfast under trial, and how has this promise been provided?

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

- 7. In what ways has this sermon given you hope and encouragement to persevere through the trials you may be going through now or will go through in the future?
- 8. How can your Life Group help each other persevere through trials and ultimately count it as all joy?
