START SHARING | Get your group engaging with the message.

- 3. What can we learn from John and Pastor Steve's teaching when it seems we are alone in our troubles (vs. 9-11)?
- 4. Why does "The Son of Man" clearly identify Jesus (vs. 12-13a)?
- 5. Revelation 1:13-16 symbolically describe Jesus. What verses can you find that corroborate the following?
 - a. Sovereignty (long robe with a golden sash).
 - b. Righteousness (hair like white snow).
 - c. Knowledge (eyes like flames of fire).
 - d. Presence (feet like burnished bronze).
 - e. Command (voice like the roar of many waters).
 - f. Shepherd (right hand He held seven stars).
 - g. Truth (from His mouth came a sharp two-edged sword).
