START TALKING | Get your group thinking.

START SHARING | Get your group engaging with the message.

- 3. Read Psalm 121:1-4 and Psalm 23:1-3. Describe how these verses encourage believers to intentionally and obediently walk in their pursuit of Jesus.
- 4. Read Isaiah 40:28 and Psalm 121:3-4. Describe the hope and comfort that is derived from God who sees you.
- 5. Read Psalm 121:5-8. Pastor Koby explained how these verses use God's personal name, Yahweh. What do these verses and the use of God's name teach us about keeping our eyes up?
- 6. Read verse 8 again. What did Pastor Koby teach about the importance of God keeping watch over us "from this time forth and forevermore"?
