START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.*

1. How do culture, social media, and movies shape our view of love and relationships?

START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.*

Read 1 Timothy 1:3-11

2. Reflect on 1 Timothy 1:5 and Matthew 22:37-39, considering the significance of loving God and those around you:
 - a. How does Jesus' teaching in Matthew 6:24 about serving two masters highlight the difference between loving God and clinging to sin?
 - b. How does Philippians 2:3-4 build holiness in godly connections with others?
 - c. What does it mean to love God with a pure heart?
3. Please read Isaiah 5:20 and 1 John 1:9. What is the problem with our conscience and how do we clear our conscience to strengthen our relationships with God and others?
4. Considering Matthew 7:21-23, why is it crucial to have an authentic and sincere faith when loving God and others?

START LIVING | *Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.*

5. How are you actively pursuing holiness? Pray for the Lord to reveal any sin you've made peace with and ask for His strength to release it.
6. Do you have a God-calibrated conscience? How do you incorporate spending time in the Word of God to understand what God loves and what He hates?
7. Is your faith sincere? What steps will you take to live out what you say you believe?
