START SHARING | Get your group engaging with the message.

Read 1 Timothy 3:1-13

- 3. Reflecting on 2 Peter 1:3, 1 Timothy 4:6 and 2 Timothy 2:15, in what ways does Pastor Koby describe how we are to be students who value the Word of God?
- 4. We are to be changed by the Word of God.

 - b. What can we glean by the warning given to the religious leaders in Matthew 23:27?
 - c. Explain the barriers of "unawareness" and "laziness" that hinder us from being transformed by the Word of God.
