START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.*

2. Read 1 Timothy 5:1-2. There is a right way and a wrong way to deal with confrontation. What do these verses and Pastor Koby teach us about dealing with confrontation?
3. Read Ephesians 4:25. Why is being honest foundational to resolving conflict in a godly manner?
4. Read Ephesians 4:26-27. What do these verses teach us about managing our anger?
5. Read Ephesians 4:29-30. Why is it important to attack the problem and not the person? See also Matthew 5:22, James 3:8-10 and Ephesians 4:15.
6. Read Ephesians 4:31-32. How does deciding who we are affect the way we act or react to those whom God has put around us?

7. What are the five questions Pastor Koby urged us to consider when dealing with conflict resolution?
8. Which of the five questions do you need to focus on most and how can your Life Group help?
