The Mortification of Sin with the Superiority of Jesus

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As men, we often fight for purity with a sense of "duty" and "should do it" type of thinking. However, we aren't to fight sin with duty but with delight. Through the eyes of faith, we behold the excellencies of Jesus and are conformed into his image (2 Cor. 3:18). Pornography and anger are besetting sins for men that must be met with the superiority of Jesus Christ.

- I. The Expulsive Power of a New Affection:
 - A. Thomas Chalmers: "There are two ways in which a practical moralist may attempt to displace from the human heart its love of the world- either by a demonstration of the world's vanity, so as that the heart shall be prevailed upon simply to withdraw its regards from an object that is not worthy of it; or, by setting forth another object, even God, as more worthy of its attachment, so as that the heart shall be prevailed upon not to resign an old affection, which shall have nothing to succeed it, but to exchange an old affection for a new one."
 - B. Conclusion: You will never rid yourself of a struggle with pornography and anger by meditating on the "inferiority" of those. You must see something else as better!
