

Men's Intentional Discipleship Description

We often talk about Discipleship and agree that it is something we all need to be involved in because of Christ's Great Commission to the Church (Matt. 28:19-29). Many of us, however, while embracing the concept of Discipleship, have never had the experience of having been discipled in an intentional, relational way. That is a problem if we are trying to create a culture of Discipleship. Therefore, we have created Men's Intentional Discipleship (Men's ID). Below is a detailed description of this training. If you are interested in learning how to become a better Disciple Maker, please consider this for yourself!

Men's Intentional Discipleship (Men's ID)

"Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us." Phil 3:17

"...what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also." 2 Tim. 2:2

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Matt. 28:19-20

The goal of Men's ID is to model relational discipleship in such a way that, whatever your starting point, you can grow in discipleship & go on to disciple others in a similar fashion. It creates a culture of men who live intentionally for the Lord and are equipped to make more and better Disciples of Jesus who can in-turn make more and better Disciples of Jesus. Men's ID provides the experience of being discipled in both small-group and one-on-one settings. It's not a full A-Z discipleship course, but it covers the basic principles and gives a taste of what intentional, relational discipleship is so that it can be passed on to others.

"Discipleship isn't just about teaching doctrine or helping people learn to evangelize, but it's about teaching people to do relationships well. If the teaching and methods in the ministry only deal with Bible knowledge and the vertical relationship and not actual, practical ways of becoming better at person-to-person relationships, then there is something majorly missing from their form of discipleship."

Men's ID runs from September through June. Members meet three times a month: one-on-one with their leader, with their small group (4-6 men & on a mutually agreed upon schedule), and with the whole "class" on the second Sunday of the month at 6:15am. Coursework (15-45min daily) focuses on building good Spiritual Habits and teaching basic foundational Christian doctrine. There is a \$225 fee for materials. *(the fee can be discussed if it proves to be a challenge.)*
