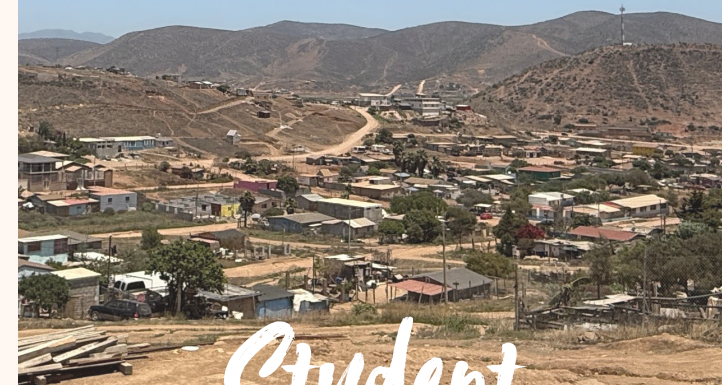

YUGO Ministries



The Ensenada Outreach Center of Yugo is located in a small, quiet, and safe suburb of Ensenada, called Chapultepec, about 2 hours south of San Diego, CA. These villages and communities we serve are in the fields and rural areas on the outskirts of Ensenada. There is much work that needs to be done in these communities to care for the hurting and lost, spread the Gospel, and encourage and strengthen the church.

MINISTRY IN MEXICO

This June, join a team of middle school students and adults as we travel to Mexico to partner with Yugo Ministries.

While in Mexico, we will partner with a local church to build a house for a family in need and intentionally care for the family and the surrounding neighborhood. The team will also partner with two churches to run a Vacation Bible School for community kids as well as canvas the local neighborhoods with Hope Bags filled with food, hygiene goods, and other needs. These opportunities open doors with the Mexican people to share the gospel and connect them to the local church.

This can be a life-changing week as we serve the Mexican people with the love of Jesus.

STAYING IN MEXICO

ACCOMMODATIONS

Accommodations are group dorms with toilets and showers, along with some great space for our team to recharge and prepare for ministry. Campus is gated and security is on site.

FOOD

Food is prepared in the YUGO Kitchen from suppliers such as Costco. Water is provided by a water purification company and dispensed on site and taken off site during ministry.

HEALTH & SAFETY

The health and safety of the team is our most important role. We partner with Yugo on these protocols as well as having our own team members dedicated to medical & security needs to provide an experience that is safe through Canyon Hills guidelines and protocols for global trips.
