



The Transformational Power of the Gospel – Col. 2:10-15

START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.*

1. The Gospel is transformational. What's one small way you've seen God grow or change you over time – something that might make your younger self say, 'wait, you do that now?'

START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.*

2. Paul says we were “*dead in our trespasses.*” Pastor Koby reminded us that we weren't just *sick* or *struggling* – we were spiritually lifeless. How does seeing sin as spiritual death (rather than just “bad choices”) change the way we understand our need for God's grace?
3. In verses 12, we learn that we were “*raised with Christ through faith in the powerful working of God.*” How does knowing that salvation is completely God's work – not something we can earn – shape the way we respond to Him?
4. What does the Bible say has happened to our sin (v. 13-14)? How does truly believing that your record of sin has been *nailed to the cross* affect the way you see yourself and your story?
5. How do verses 12-15 demonstrate God's amazing grace and our complete forgiveness?

START LIVING | *Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.*

6. What is one practical way you can live this week as someone who's been made new in Christ – at home, at work, or in your relationships?
7. Pastor Koby said when you hide your sinful past, you conceal the grace of God. Your testimony is not about your failure – it's about His grace. Who in your life might need to hear how God has transformed you? And how can we make our everyday conversations more about what God has done rather than what we've done?
