## START TALKING | Get your group thinking.

1. What's one area of life that's changed the most for you in the last few years?

## START SHARING | Get your group engaging with the message.

- 2. Paul warns believers to "let no one pass judgment on you." What kind of pressure were the Colossians facing, and what are similar pressures believers face today?
- 3. What does Paul mean by being "disqualified" in v. 18?
- 4. In the message, 3 warning signs of Legalism were listed. Which one of these have you struggled with in the past and why?
  - a. Checking spiritual boxes instead of pursuing Jesus
  - b. Criticizing other believers who don't meet your standards
  - c. Feeling like you have to earn God's approval
- 5. Read Galatians 1:6-9 together. What are some other "modern" false gospels that are taught today? (e.g. health & wealth, self-help, political gospels, etc.) Why is Paul so passionate about protecting the purity of the gospel?
- 6. What false teachings or cultural messages about faith are most common or tempting today?

## START LIVING | Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.

- 7. Have you ever been part of a church, or season in your faith, where it felt more about rules than relationship? How did that affect your joy and sense of freedom?
- 8. What personal preferences or traditions do you sometimes elevate as "spiritual musts"?
- 9. Paul calls believers to take responsibility for what influences them. What are some influences (media voices, habits) that might be dulling your discernment?
