START TALKING | Get your group thinking.

1. What is one 'old habit' from your past that took you a while to unlearn?

START SHARING | Get your group engaging with the message.

- 2. According to Col. 3:1-4, what reasons does Paul give for why believers are considered citizens of heaven even while still living on earth?
- 3. In this passage, Paul uses both past-tense ("you have died") and present-tense realities ("your life is hidden with Christ"). What do these grammatical choices reveal about the "already" and "not yet" aspects of being made new in Christ?
- 4. What does Paul mean when he commands us to "seek the things above" and "set your minds on things above"? How should this shape the way we live each day?
- 5. How do verses 3-4 describe the believer's current spiritual reality ("hidden with Christ") and their future reality ("you also will appear with him in glory")? What hope should this bring to believers?

START LIVING | Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.

- 6. What is one practical change you could make this week big or small that would help reorient your desires or thinking toward the things of Christ rather than the things of earth?
- 7. If our life is "hidden with Christ" and our future "glory" is guaranteed, how should that impact the way you respond to stress, conflict, or discouragement in your daily routine?
