### **START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.***

1. What is one 'old habit' from your past that took you a while to unlearn?

### **START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.***

2. According to Col. 3:1-4, what reasons does Paul give for why believers are considered citizens of heaven even while still living on earth?
3. In this passage, Paul uses both past-tense ("*you have died*") and present-tense realities ("*your life is hidden with Christ*"). What do these grammatical choices reveal about the "already" and "not yet" aspects of being made new in Christ?
4. What does Paul mean when he commands us to "*seek the things above*" and "*set your minds on things above*"? How should this shape the way we live each day?
5. How do verses 3-4 describe the believer's current spiritual reality ("*hidden with Christ*") and their future reality ("*you also will appear with him in glory*")? What hope should this bring to believers?

### **START LIVING | *Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.***

6. What is one practical change you could make this week – big or small – that would help reorient your desires or thinking toward the things of Christ rather than the things of earth?
7. If our life is "*hidden with Christ*" and our future "*glory*" is guaranteed, how should that impact the way you respond to stress, conflict, or discouragement in your daily routine?
