START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.*

1. What's something that's way more fun or easier to do *with other people* than by yourself?

START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.*

2. The Big Idea was: **God commands us to love one another, and we obey best in community.** What are some excuses we make that prevent us from obeying this command?
3. Hebrews 10 says we are to “*consider how to stir up one another to love and good works.*” What does it mean to stir one another up? What prevents us from actually stirring up one another?
4. Pastor John shared that we love one another by meeting together, and we are commanded not to neglect that (Heb. 10:25). Why do you think God ties love, perseverance, and encouragement so closely to physically being together?
5. In Ecclesiastes 4 and Hebrews 10, what assumptions does Scripture make about how believers are supposed to relate to one another – and how is that different from how people usually think about church today?

START LIVING | *Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.*

6. Based on Sunday's sermon, what is one specific way God may be inviting you to more intentionally show up in Christian community right now – whether in consistency, presence, or engagement?
7. Jesus says people will know we are His disciples by our love for one another. What is one simple, intentional way you can practice that kind of love toward someone in your life this week?
