START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.*

1. What's something you can't help but celebrate loudly – like a sports moment, a concert, good news?

START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.*

2. Every Christian is called to worship. What commands related to worship do you notice in the opening verses of Psalm 33 (v.1-3)?
3. We worship God because of WHO He is. What specific attributes do we see about God as found in Psalm 33?
4. We worship God because He reigns (v. 10-17). How does worship help us remember who is truly in control?
5. We worship God because He is our hope (v. 18-22). How does worship remind the church of what is true about God's presence and protection (see also Isaiah 41:10, Psalm 3:3)?

START LIVING | *Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.*

6. When you gather for corporate worship, what most often shapes your engagement – your circumstances and mood, or the reality of who God is? What might help you stay more focused on who God is during worship?
7. Worship reminds us that God is our help and our hope. Is there an area of life right now where you need that reminder more than usual?
8. How can our group encourage one another to keep our eyes on the Lord together?
