What We Do: Go – Romans 10:13-15

START TALKING | Get your group thinking.

1. What has been your experience with global missions? Have you ever gone on a mission trip?

START SHARING | Get your group engaging with the message.

2. The Big Idea was that, “Every Christian is called to reach the nations for Jesus.” Based on the scriptures mentioned (*Rom. 10, Matt. 28:18-19, John 20:21*) how does the Bible support that this calling is universal and not limited to a select few?
3. Pastor Koby mentioned various people God used (Moses, Gideon, Peter, William Carey), what seems to be the primary qualification for those God calls to go?
4. There are two roles for believers: “goers” and “senders.” According to Romans 10:14-15, how do these roles depend on each other? Why do you think Paul treats both as essential to the mission?
5. Some are called to go, some to send, but we are ALL called to participate. How does John 20:21 support that idea?

START LIVING | Get your group applying God’s Word to daily life.

6. As you think about all Christians being called to participate in God’s mission, where do you sense the greatest tension for you right now – going, sending, or simply engaging more intentionally?
7. Based on how you answered the above question...what might it look like for you to take a next step of obedience in participating in God’s mission, even if you don’t feel particularly qualified or ready?
