Putting on Kindness – Colossians 3:12-14

START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.*

1. What is one memorable act of kindness that you have had someone do for you?

START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.*

2. Paul addresses believers as “*God’s chosen ones, holy and beloved*” before telling them to put on kindness and other qualities (Col. 3:12). Why do you think Paul starts with their identity before giving these commands?
3. Kindness was defined as “active goodness toward the undeserving.” How does that definition compare with the way our culture typically thinks about kindness?
4. In the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:30-37), why do you think Jesus chose a Samaritan – someone viewed as the enemy – to be the example of true neighborly kindness?
5. Biblical kindness is both costly and active. Why do you think Scripture consistently connects kindness with sacrifice rather than convenience?

START LIVING | *Get your group applying God’s Word to daily life.*

6. Romans 2:4 says God’s kindness leads us to repentance. How might your kindness toward others help point people toward Christ?
7. Who are some people in your everyday life who might be easy to overlook, but could benefit from intentional kindness right now?
