## Good News For Everyone – John 4:3-30

### **START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.***

1. Have you ever received something you felt completely undeserving of? What was that like for you?

### **START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.***

2. What stands out to you most about Jesus choosing to engage with the Samaritan woman? How does that challenge or expand your view of who the gospel is really for?
3. Jeremiah describes people turning from God (the “living water”) to broken cisterns (Jer. 2:13). What are some “broken cisterns” people today tend to turn to for identity, security or satisfaction?
4. Jesus shifts the conversation from physical water to “living water.” What is He communicating through that metaphor, and why would that have been meaningful to the Samaritan woman?
5. The woman immediately shared her story without shame after encountering Jesus (John 4:28-30). What tends to hold us back from being open about our faith?

### **START LIVING | *Get your group applying God’s Word to daily life.***

6. Since Jesus truly satisfies our “spiritual thirst,” what might it look like in a normal week to go to Him instead of defaulting to other sources for satisfaction?
7. Jesus intentionally engaged someone others would have avoided. What might it look like in everyday life to be more aware of – and open to – people we might normally overlook or avoid?
