Start Talking | Get Your Group Thinking

1. What's the difference between knowing someone and trusting someone?
2. Think about a time when someone really listened to you compared to a time when someone didn't. How did the difference make you feel?

Start Sharing | Get Your Group Engaging with the Message

1. In Matthew 6:5–6, Jesus talks about praying to be seen by others versus praying because we want to spend time with God. What do you think Jesus is teaching us about why we pray?
2. Pastor Koby said that God already knows what we need, but He still wants us to talk to Him. Why do you think God wants us to pray even when He already knows what we need?
3. Does your idea of what a father is like line up with how God describes Himself as our Father? Why or why not?

Start Living | Get Your Group Applying God's Word to Daily Life

4. Choose a time this week to practice spending time in prayer, believing that God is completely focused on you—caring for you and listening to YOU.
5. Write out a few of your prayers. What do they reveal about what you believe about God? Are you trusting Him to provide, or relying on yourself?
